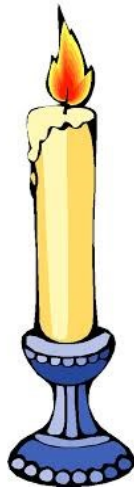

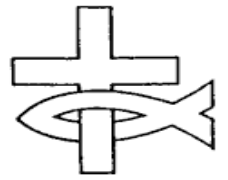
Giant Flea Market
